When to Go to the Emergency Room -	
What you may be experiencing:	How you may feel:
Signs of a heart attack	Pressure, fullness, squeezing or pain in the center of your chest, tightness, burning or aching under the breastbone, chest pain with lightheadedness
Signs of a stroke	Sudden weakness, numbness of the face, arm or leg on one side of the body; sudden dimness or loss of vision, especially in one eye; loss of speech, trouble talking or understanding someone else talking; sudden severe headaches with no cause; dizziness with no cause, unsteadiness or sudden falls, especially when having other symptoms of stroke.
Severe shortness of breath	
Bleeding	Does not stop after 10 minutes of direct pressure
New severe pain	Different pain too bad to go about your daily activities
Poisoning	Call Poison Control 1-800-222-1222 and ask for immediate home treatment advice, it could save your life
Severe or worsening reaction to an insect bite, sting or to medications	If breathing is difficult
Major injury	Like a head injury
Unexplained confusion, disorientation or lethargy Coughing up or vomiting blood Severe or persistent vomiting	Drowsiness, disorientation or confusion
Suicidal or homicidal feelings
