Screening for Future Fall Risk	Patients, age 65+, need to be screened for future fall risk in 2019	Tip: Have patients complete the Medicare Screening Questionnaire, scan it into the patients documents, and mark the fall screening in your EHR's designated fields
	Exceptions: Documentation of medical reason(s) for not screening for fall risk	
Tobacco Use: Screening and Cessation Intervention	Patients, age 18+, who were screened for tobacco use one or more times within 24 months and received cessation counseling at most recent screening if identified as a tobacco user	Tobacco use includes any type of tobacco (smoke and smokeless). Patient must be screened for tobacco, not just smoking.
	Exceptions: Medical reason for not screening (ex. Limited life expectancy)
